



Responsible Travel & Sustainable Tourism Policy

Fuoritinerario's responsible tourism framework is built around **environmental care, social responsibility, and cultural preservation**. These principles apply to internal operations, product design, supplier selection, and traveler guidance. The company's objective is to reduce negative impacts associated with tourism activities while supporting local economies, safeguarding cultural assets, and encouraging respectful interaction between travelers and host communities.



Operational Practices

- Offices and internal operations

Our Responsible Travel & Sustainable Tourism Policy is integrated into internal operations through **measurable daily practices**.

Our offices in Perugia and Milan are located near major transportation hubs, supporting low-impact mobility. Fuoritinerario uses energy-efficient systems, extends the lifecycle of its equipment, and applies strict paper and plastic reduction policies. Waste separation and filtered tap water are standard practices. All employment conditions fully comply with Italian labor law.

- Tour design and travel experiences

Fuoritinerario designs tours exclusively for small groups and private travelers to **limit pressure on destinations and facilitate meaningful cultural exchange**. Itineraries include lesser-known locations and alternative visiting schedules, even in high-profile destinations. Low-season travel, walking tours, and public transportation are actively encouraged. Food experiences focus on regional traditions and local supply chains, including restaurants aligned with the principles of the Slow Food Movement.

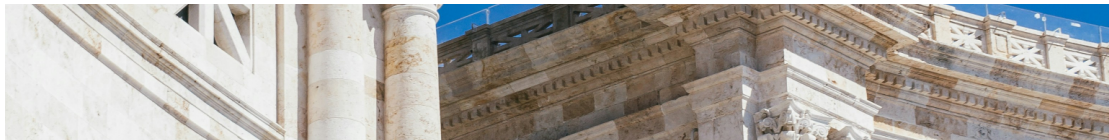


- Local partners & suppliers

The company works primarily with **locally owned and Italian-managed suppliers**. These include small hotels, traditional restaurants, certified local guides, professional drivers, and artisans. Supplier selection prioritizes businesses that demonstrate responsible practices and compliance with recognized Italian and international sustainability guidelines. This model supports local economic resilience and ensures operational transparency.

- Legal compliance and ethical standards

Fuoritinerario operates as a **fully licensed and bonded Italian tour operator**, in compliance with national tourism legislation. All guides and drivers engaged are officially authorized. Professional conduct, legality, and respect for people are governed by the company's **Code of Ethics**, which applies to employees, collaborators, suppliers, and partners.
